



March 9, 2011 CSBASC Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:08 pm by residing president Rich Tharp. Tharp had asked each person to identify themselves do to the nature of some new faces. The roll call of officers and managers was read. Tharp then welcomed all in attendance. For the sake of time, the topic of background checks was moved to the top of the list.
